

ESIL Interest Group on International Health Law

Annual Report 2021-2022

The ESIL Interest Group (IG) on International Health Law remained active in the organisation of events and in the publication of the output of past meetings. The focus was mostly on legal issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

On 30 March, 2022, the IG Coordinating Committee hosted a side-event in the aegis of the 2022 ESIL Research Forum in Glasgow, entitled *International Law and Global Health Security: Lessons from the COVID-19 Pandemic*. After a call for papers was disseminated, six submissions from early career scholars were selected for presentation at the workshop. Committee Member Stéphanie Dagon (University of Geneva, Switzerland) gave a keynote speech on the subject “Between Intuition and Reality: Is Universal Health Coverage Essential for Global Health Security?”. The event included participants from Italy, the United Kingdom and the United States of America, and was organized under a hybrid format.

Members of the Coordinating Committee of the IG on International Health Law plans to participate in the upcoming ESIL Annual Conference in Aix-en-Provence. For that purpose, proposals will be prepared and submitted.
