For the year 2020-2021, the Organising Committee of the ESIL Interest Group on International Law and Technology consisted of Abhivardhan, Rebecca Mignot-Mahdavi, Gavin Sullivan, Dimitri Van Den Meerssche, and Roxana Vatanparast.

The Interest Group was formed in 2020. Due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, many ESIL events were postponed. The Interest Group postponed its first workshop due to the postponement of the ESIL Annual Conference in Stockholm to 2021.

• The Interest Group planned its first Workshop in a hybrid 2-day pre-conference workshop on September 7-8, 2021 held online via Zoom on the first day and in a hybrid format at Stockholm University and online via Zoom on the second day. The Workshop, organized after an open Call for Papers, brought together over 24 scholars to present on the topic of "International Law in the Age of the Algorithm." Abhivardhan, Daniela Gandorfer, Geoffrey Gordon, Fleur Johns, Rebecca Mignot-Mahdavi, Gregor Noll, Dimitri Van Den Meerssche, and Roxana Vatanparast served as chairs and
