The Interest Group's main event this year was the History of International Law IG Pre-Conference Hybrid Workshop 'Histories of Inclusion/Exclusion in International Law' which was attached to the ESIL Meeting at Utrecht, 31 August – 1 September 2022. A total of 9 excellent scholarly presentations were made.

ESIL IGHIL Blog

The ESIL IGHIL Blog continues to be a reference for interested researchers in legal history, international law, diplomatic history, legal theory, and philosophy of law.

Numerous announcements of books, calls for papers, notifications of journal issues as well as of both online and physical conferences have been posted since the creation of the Blog. In many case notification of new books and issues of journals is accompanied by an outline of contents and a brief overview.

In the last twelve months (up to 23 September), the blog counts over 14 000 views per month, with sparks of 1 520
